LET'S WEIGH THE EVIDENCE

Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.
1 Thessalonians 5:21

"THE NWT HAS THE NAME OF JEHOVAH PUT BACK IN WHERE THE KJV HAS IT ONLY IN 4 PLACES. The texts that today's Bibles came from had His Name in it about 7,000 times. Over the years it was thought that God's Name not be pronounced **SO MAN TOOK THE NAME OF GOD OUT AND REPLACED IT WITH LORD OR GOD. God does have a personal name. Jesus said to make His Name sanctified in all the earth. That is not God, as there was lesser gods in the Bible. **THAT NAME IS JEHOVAH.**"**

BECAUSE IT PUT GOD'S NAME JEHOVAH BACK WHERE IT BELONGED. (Psalms 83:18 in KJV along with the pages in the front will confirm that they took out in order to follow a Jewish tradition rather than a Christian one. See John chapter 17 to see that Jesus made God's name known.)

**Now If we follow the JWT's / NWT Train of thought then both translations should call Jesus JEHOVAH
According to this passage in both versions**

1 Corinthians 12:3(KJV) Remember LORD = JEHOVAH!

Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth **Jesus** accursed: and that **NO MAN CAN SAY THAT JESUS IS THE LORD, BUT BY THE HOLY GHOST.**

NWT: Now I would have you know that nobody when speaking by God's spirit says: "Jesus is accursed!" and NOBODY CAN SAY: "JESUS IS LORD!" EXCEPT BY HOLY SPIRIT.±

Notice that they DELIBERATELY DID NOT CHANGE LORD TO JEHOVAH in the passage we just read IN THE NWT

Now we're going to go head to head, verse to verse in a comparison to see if indeed BOTH VERSIONS ESTABLISH that Jehovah indeed became the Only Begotten Son of God

For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's.⁹ For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.¹⁰ But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.¹¹ For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.

ROMANS 14:8-12(NWT)

For if we live, we live to Jehovah,*+ and if we die, we die to Jehovah.* So both if we live and if we die, we belong to Jehovah.*+⁹ For to this end Christ died and came to life again, so that he might be Lord over both the dead and the living.+¹⁰ But why do you judge your brother?+ Or why do you also look down on your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.+¹¹ For it is written: "As surely as I live,'+ says Jehovah,* 'to me every knee will bend, and every tongue will make open acknowledgment to God.'" +¹² So, then, each of us will render an account for himself to God.+

MORE IN THE NWT, JEHOVAH IS THE JUDGE REFERENCES:

Genesis 18:25

It is unthinkable that you would act in this manner by putting the righteous man to death with the wicked one so that the outcome for the righteous man and the wicked is the same!+ It is unthinkable of you.+ Will the Judge of all the earth not do what is right?"+

She will give birth to a son, and **you are to name him Jesus,* + for he will save his people from their sins.**⁺²² All of this actually came about to fulfill what was spoken by Jehovah* through his prophet, saying:²³ "Look! The virgin will become pregnant and will give birth to a son, and they will name him Im'man'u'el,"⁺ **which means, when translated, "With Us Is God."**⁺

Isaiah 9:6(KJV)

For unto us a child is born, unto us **a son is given:** and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and **his name** shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, **The everlasting Father,** The Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 9:6(NWT)

For a child has been born to us,⁺ **A son has been given** to us; And the rulership* will rest on his shoulder.⁺ **His name** will be called Wonderful Counselor,⁺ Mighty God,⁺ **Eternal Father,** Prince of Peace.

John 10:25(KJV)

Jesus answered them, **I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.**

John 10:25(NWT)

Jesus answered them: "I told you, and yet you do not believe. The works that I am doing in my **Father's name,** these bear witness about me.⁺

John 5:43(KJV)

I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

John 5:43(NWT)

I have come in **the name of my Father,** but you do not receive me. If someone else came in his own name, you would receive that one

Zechariah 11:11-13 King James Version (KJV)

And it was broken in that day: and so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it was the word of the LORD.¹² And I said unto them, **If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.**¹³ **And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prized at of them.** And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

Matthew 27:8-10 (NWT)

Therefore, that field has been called Field of Blood⁺ to this very day.⁹ Then what was spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled: **"And they took the 30 silver pieces, the price that was set on the man, the one on whom a price was set by some of the sons of Israel,**¹⁰ and they gave them for the potter's field, according to what Jehovah* had commanded me."

Isaiah 50:3-6

Jehovah went on to say to Moses: "I will also do this thing that you request, because you have found favor in my eyes and I know you by name."¹⁸ Then he said: "Please show me your glory."¹⁹ But he said: "I will make all my goodness pass before your face, **and I will declare before you the name of Jehovah**;⁺ and I will favor the one whom I favor, and I will show mercy to the one to whom I show mercy."⁺²⁰ But he added: "**You cannot see my face, for no man can see me and live.**"²¹ Jehovah said further: "Here is a place near me. Station yourself on the rock.²² When my glory is passing by, I will place you in a crevice of the rock, **and I will shield you with my hand** until I have passed by.²³ After that **I will take my hand away, and you will see my back**. But my face may not be seen."⁺

MORE ON NO MAN HAS SEEN GOD

John 1:18 (MOSES SAW JEHOVAH)

No man has seen God at any time;⁺ the only-begotten god⁺ who is at the Father's side*⁺ is the one who has explained Him.⁺

John 6:46 (NOW EVEN THEY'RE BOOK SAYS JEHOVAH IS NOT THE FATHER)

Not that any man has seen the Father,⁺ except the one who is from God; this one has seen the Father.⁺

Deuteronomy 4:11, 12 (DIRECT PROOF JEHOVAH IS NOT THE FATHER IN THE NWT)

"So you came near and stood at the base of the mountain, and the mountain was burning with fire up to the very heavens;* there was darkness, cloud, and thick gloom.⁺¹² **And Jehovah began to speak to you out of the fire.⁺ You heard the sound of words, but you saw no form⁺—there was only a voice.⁺**

OUR CONCLUSION BASED ON THE EVIDENCE IN BOTH THE KJV & NWT IS THEREFORE THIS:

JEHOVAH DID COME DOWN AND BECAME THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON (Zech 8:3)

"This is what Jehovah says, **'I will return to Zion⁺** and reside in Jerusalem;⁺ and Jerusalem will be called the city of truth,⁺ and the mountain of Jehovah of armies, the holy mountain."⁺

AND JEHOVAH HIMSELF WAS THERE IN JERUSALEM (Ezk 35:10)

"Because you said, 'These two nations and these two lands will become mine, and we will take possession of both,'⁺ **even though Jehovah himself was there,**

THEREFORE JEHOVAH AND JESUS THE ONLY BEGOTTEN SON OF GOD ARE THE SAME BEING
