PIG and PORK FACTS

FROM OUR DIETARY LAW HIGHLIGHT SERIES

THE pig or swine is a very popular food item with so-called Christians. Yet these very Christians are unaware that the God they profess to believe in Jesus had condemned the eating of swine's flesh and at his 2nd coming will destroy all those that eat pigs flesh.

A COMING OF THE LORD FACT THAT SATANIZED CHRISTIANS IGNORE

For, behold THE LORD will come with FIRE, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by his sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be many. They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree in the midst, EATING SWINE'S FLESH and the ABOMINATION and the MOUSE, shall be consumed together, saith the LORD(Isaiah 66:15-17)

THE APOSTLE PAUL WROTE ABOUT THE SAME COMING OF THE LORD

And to you who are troubled reat with us when **THE LORD JESUS** shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels. **IN FLAMING FIRE** taking vengeance on them that **KNOW NOT GOD AND THAT OBEY NOT THE GOSPEL** of our **LORD JESUS CHRIST** (2 Thessalonians 1:7-8)

The condemnation is based on both sound biological and spiritual principles. Here are some biological facts on pork that prove it to be a very unhealthy food to eat:

- A pig is a real garbage gut. It will eat anything including urine, excrement, dirt, decaying animal flesh, maggots, or decaying vegetables. They will even eat the cancerous growths off other pigs or animals.
- The meat and fat of a pig absorbs toxins like a sponge. Their meat can be 30 times more toxic than beef or venison.
- ●When eating beef or venison, it takes 8 to 9 hours to digest the meat so what little toxins are in the meat are slowly put into our system and can be filtered by the liver. But when pork is eaten, IT TAKES ONLY 4 HOURS TO DIGEST THE MEAT. We thus get a much higher level of toxins within a shorter time.
- •Unlike other mammals, A PIG DOES NOT SWEAT OR PERSPIRE. Perspiration is a means by which toxins are removed from the body. Since a pig does not sweat, the toxins remain within its body and in the meat.
- •Pigs and swine are so poisonous that you can hardly kill them with strychnine or other poisons.
- Farmers will often pen up pigs within a rattlesnake nest because the pigs will eat the snakes, and if bitten THEY WILL NOT BE HARMED BY THE VENOM.

- •When a pig is butchered, worms and insects take to its flesh sooner and faster than to other animal's flesh. IN A FEW DAYS THE SWINE FLESH IS FULL OF WORMS.
- Swine and pigs have over a dozen parasites within them, such as tapeworms, flukes, worms, and trichinae. THERE IS NO SAFE TEMPERATURE AT WHICH PORK CAN BE COOKED TO ENSURE THAT ALL THESE PARASITES, THEIR CYSTS, AND EGGS WILL BE KILLED.
- Pig meat has twice as much fat as beef. A 3 oz T bone steak contains 8.5 grams of fat; a 3 oz **PORK CHOP CONTAINS 18 GRAMS OF FAT**. A 3 oz beef rib has 11.1 grams of fat; a 3 oz pork spare rib has 23.2 grams of fat.
- Cows have a complex digestive system, having four stomachs. It thus takes over 24 hours to digest their vegetarian diet causing its food to be purified of toxins. In contrast, the swine's one stomach TAKES ONLY ABOUT 4 HOURS TO DIGEST ITS FOUL DIET, TURNING ITS TOXIC FOOD INTO FLESH.
- The swine carries about **30 DISEASES WHICH CAN BE EASILY PASSED TO HUMANS**. This is why God commanded that we are not even to touch their carcase (Leviticus 11:8).
- The trichinae worm of the swine is microscopically small, and once ingested can lodge itself in our intestines, muscles, spinal cord or the brain. This results in the disease trichinosis. The symptoms are sometimes lacking, but when present they ARE MISTAKEN FOR OTHER DISEASES, SUCH AS TYPHOID, ARTHRITIS, RHEUMATISM, GASTRITIS, MS, MENINGITIS, GALL BLADDER TROUBLE, OR ACUTE ALCOHOLISM.
- The pig is so poisonous and filthy, that NATURE HAD TO PREPARE HIM A SEWER LINE OR CANAL RUNNING DOWN EACH LEG WITH AN OUTLET IN THE BOTTOM OF THE FOOT. Out of this hole oozes pus and filth his body cannot pass into its system fast enough. Some of this pus gets into the meat of the pig.

There are other reasons grounded in biological facts that could be listed to show why pigs and swine should not be eaten. But a true Christian should only need one reason why not to eat this type of food because God prohibited it.

"And the swine, because it divides the hoof, yet does not chew the cud, it is unclean unto you: you shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcase." - Leviticus 11:7,8; Deuteronomy 14:8

Those who say Christ abolished the law condemning pork are motivated by their stomach not Scripture. The problems with pork are biological, and CHRIST NEVER CHANGED THE LAWS OF BIOLOGY.

DISEASES FROM PORK THAT PASS TO HUMANS

Pork is a healthy source of protein, iron and zinc, but must be cooked properly to avoid illness. According to the United States Department of Agriculture Food Safety and Inspection Service, pork should be cooked to an internal temperature of 145 degrees Fahrenheit to kill the germs, bacteria and parasites that can lead to most food-borne illnesses. Once you know more about the diseases pork can cause, you can take the steps necessary to protect yourself.

Salmonella

Salmonella is caused by eating food contaminated with animal feces. Symptoms of salmonella generally occur within the first 12 to 72 hours after infection. Salmonella causes fever, diarrhea and abdominal cramps and usually lasts for about one week. In most cases, infected individuals recover without treatment, though it may take several weeks before your bowel habits return to normal. In more severe cases, the infection can move into the bloodstream, which can cause death if not treated immediately. Antibiotics are not usually effective unless the infection spreads out of the intestines.

E. coli

Pigs can transfer E.coli to humans, though they do not usually get sick themselves. E.coli causes severe abdominal cramps, vomiting and diarrhea, which can be bloody. A mild fever might also be present with an E.coli infection. Many cases of E.coli are mild and go away on their own. In more serious cases, E.coli can cause hemolytic uremic syndrome, or HUS. HUS can be life-threatening and causes decreased urination, fatigue and changes in skin color on the cheeks and around the eyes. E.coli does not respond to antibiotics.

Trichinellosis

Pork that is infected with the larva of a worm called Trichinella can cause trichinellosis. The first symptoms of trichinellosis include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, fever and abdominal pain. Later an infected person can develop headache, joint pain, muscle pain, cough, eye swelling and constipation. It can take several months for the symptoms of trichinellosis to disappear completely. Severe cases can cause heart and breathing problems or death. Antibiotics are usually necessary to treat trichinellosis.

Listeriosis

Listeriosis is caused by the Listeria monocytogenes bacteria, and most commonly affects pregnant women, older adults, babies and individuals with weak immune systems. Gastrointestinal symptoms, such as diarrhea, are often the first sign of an infection, but an infected person might also experience fever and muscle aches. Infections that occur in pregnant women can cause miscarriage, stillbirth or premature delivery. Listeriosis is treated with antibiotics.

Staphylococcus Aureus

Staphylococcus aureus is perhaps one of the most dangerous illnesses that humans can get from eating pork because it cannot be destroyed through the cooking process. Sliced meat, such as ham, is a common source of Staphylococcus aureus. Symptoms can begin within 30 minutes after eating contaminated pork, and include nausea, vomiting, abdominal cramps and diarrhea. The illness is usually mild and goes away on its own within three days. Antibiotics are not effective for treating this illness.
